Norm Thurston's .05 Hypocrisy

Rep. Norman Thurston recently introduced legislation amending Utah's controversial .05 DUI law to allow gun owners to carry their firearms while at the .05 limit. Thurston and Utah lawmakers can't have it both ways: If someone is sober enough to safely handle a firearm at .05, they can't also be too drunk to drive and jailed for a DUI. Passing this amendment would prove that legislators don't actually believe people are meaningfully impaired at .05—which amounts to little more than a single drink for a 120-pound woman.

It's time to repeal the .05 BAC arrest law.
